

April 21, 2026

The 146th Annual Meeting for the Town Board of Rietbrock was held Tuesday April 21, 2026, at 8:00PM at the Rietbrock Town Hall. In attendance were all Town Officials and thirty-two (32) residents/landowners. Chairman Todd Thurs called the meeting to order at 8:00PM and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Chairman stated the order of business and introduced the Board. Todd Thurs Chairman, Bradley Murkowski and Timothy O'Brien, Supervisors, Sherry Literski, Treasurer, Jody Davis, Clerk. Also introduced was Rebecca Hein who will be taking over as Town Treasurer effective July 1, 2026, with Sherry retiring.

The Chairman asked for agenda items to be discussed. The following were added:

- Dan Daniels – Chloride on Pioneer Rd
- Dan Daniels – Ditching along Mt View Lane and lot line
- Bernie Lewis – Sign on the corner of Aspen Valley Road and Urmanski Road
- Craig Christians – Speed limit on Meridian Road
- Ray Urmanski – Change traffic stop signs for traffic flow.

Clerk Jody Davis read the minutes from April 15, 2025, Annual Meeting. A motion to approve minutes was made by Wayne Gajewski, 2nd by Ray Urmanski. With all in attendance in agreement, MC at 8:11PM.

Clerk Jody Davis read the minutes from November 10, 2025, Budget Hearing. A motion to approved minutes was made by Ray Urmanski and 2nd by Wayne Gajewski. With all in attendance in agreement, MC at 8:15PM.

Sherry Literski presented the 2025 Annual Report and the financial status of the Town. A motion to approve the 2025 Annual Report and Financials was made by Duane Rauen, 2nd by Ray Urmanski. With all in attendance in agreement, MC at 8:18PM

Public input and action topics were discussed.

Dan Daniels spoke of chloride and asked if the same application can be applied this year as was completed in 2025. Dan Daniels will pay for his portion of 400ft to be applied on the north leg of the Mt View Lane, Pioneer Road intersection. The town will not apply and pay for chloride on the East and South legs of this intersection at this time. With the stop signs being applied late last year, evaluations will determine if there is a need for chloride on these legs.

The town will investigate ditching that needs to be completed on Mt. View Lane.

Bernie Lewis is asking for the street sign marking the Aspen Valley Road and Urmanski Road intersection to be moved from the Southeast corner to the Northeast corner. The street sign is not visible where it is currently located.

During this discussion, the stop sign change Ray Urmanski recommended was also discussed. The town will look to change the Street signs and evaluate whether the stop sign can be moved to be on the South side of Aspen Valley Rd, allowing traffic to freely turn north/south from Urmanski Road without a stop sign.

Craig Christians asked to change the speed limit on Meridian Road to 45 MPH from County Road U to Creekview Road. Safety is a concern with the excessive speed of vehicles. Russ

Wiegand made a motion, 2nd by Craig Christians to post and change the speed limit on Meridian Road from County Road U, north to Creekview Road to 45 MPH. A hand vote was taken. YES-27 votes, NO-2 votes. MC

Duane Rauen has questions about cleaning out ditches. Does the town need to be contacted if ditching county road? The answer is No. The County must be contacted. If town roads require/need ditching, contact the Town Supervisors with any questions.

Dan Daniels has a question about the updates for wind turbines. There is no known information on the progress of this.

There was a suggestion to work to form grant writing and investigation for road funding.

Todd Thurs provided a list of culverts known to need repair.

There were no other discussions on any and all business as authorized by law.

Craig Christians made a motion, 2nd by Wayne Mauer to set the 2026 Annual Meeting date to Tuesday April 20, 2027. With all in attendance in agreement, MC at 9:08PM

Wayne Gajewski made a motion 2nd by Gary Lewis to adjourn the meeting. MC

The meeting was adjourned at 9:09PM
